Amy Fairchild reported that staffing levels are steady and MMR is fully staffed in Traverse City. MMR may hold an EMT bootcamp that runs for 5 days a week for 7 weeks and then the student will be a certified EMT. MMR is purchasing an Echo unit which is an ALS intercept SUV. There

were 281 calls in Garfield Township in December and 320 calls in January. Response times are well within range.
